

**CAUCUS MEETING MINUTES**  
**JUNE 30, 2014**

The Meeting was called to order by Mayor Forbes.

The flag salute was led by Mayor Forbes.

Mayor Forbes announced that the meeting was in compliance with the Sunshine Law.

Council Persons present Davidson, DiMarco, Rafferty, Brandley, Aron and Lehman.

Greg Fusco from Key Engineer's gave the Engineer's Report and answered questions from Mayor and Council .  
Special Presentation-Chief Cairns from the Oaklyn Fire Department gave a special presentation on the current condition of the Fire Department's vehicles. Representatives from First Choice Fire Apparatus also gave a presentation on new Fire equipment.

Motion to open the floor to the public by Rafferty and seconded by DiMarco.

The foregoing resolution was approved by motion of Rafferty, seconded by Aron. Unanimous roll call vote.

**RESOLUTION 103-14-RAFFLE LICENSE, OAKLYN BETTLEWOOD LITTLE LEAGUE**-to approve a Raffle License for Oaklyn Bettlewood Little League.

The foregoing resolution was approved by motion of Rafferty, seconded by DiMarco. Aron-abstain, Brandley-yes, Davidson-yes, DiMarco-yes, Lehman-yes, Rafferty-yes. Motion passed.

Council went over the Tentative Agenda for the council meeting.

Council discussed an overnight parking appeal that was discussed at the June caucus meeting. Councilman Brandley will contact the owners of the vehicles for further information.

Chief Moore reported that a training session will be starting in September for a K9. Council discussed if purchasing a K9 this year would be feasible. Council asked Chief Moore to get some more information for the Council meeting next week..

Mayor Forbes discussed a possible Shared Services Agreement for court services with the Boroughs of Barrington and Haddon Heights.

Mayor Forbes gave an update on the White Horse Pike Redevelopment.

Councilman Davidson discussed the employee evaluation form.

The Borough's annual 4th of July Parade will take place on July 4th at 10:00 a.m.

Council will take nominations for Volunteer of the Year.

Council discussed amending Chapter 58, Bush, Weeds and Trees. The amendment will have a first reading at the Council meeting next week.
