

CAUCUS MEETING MINUTES

October 5, 2015

The Meeting was called to order by Mayor Forbes.

The flag salute was led by Mayor Forbes.

Mayor Forbes announced that the meeting was in compliance with the Sunshine Law.

Council Persons present : Rafferty, Davidson, Brandley, Valianti and Lehman. Councilman Aron was not present.

Greg Fusco, Borough Engineer went over the October Engineer's report and answered questions form Mayor and Council.

Council went over the tentative agenda for the Council Meeting.

Mayor and Council discussed the results of the 2015 Best Practices Inventory worksheet.

Application was made by the Oaklyn PTA for a coin toss on Saturday, October 10. Chief Moore had an issue with the map showing the organization would be located in Haddon Twp/Audubon. Council decided that the application would be approved if a new map was submitted.

Mayor Forbes gave a redevelopment update.

Council discussed amending Borough Ordinance, Chapter 125, Zoning, in regards to "decks" being constructed on the front of residential properties. Borough Solicitor Tim Higgins will prepare an amendment for first reading at the next council meeting.

Steve Depierri, Borough Fire Marshal, spoke to Mayor and Council about the need to "Knox" boxes on businesses in town. Chief Mark Moore and Fire Chief Scott Cairns are going to do some further investigation.

The meeting was open to the public by motion of Davidson, second by Valianti.

Lou Monyous-103 Johnson Ave.-asked if the "Knox" boxes were just for business or can they be used for residences. Chief Cairns said they usually are just used for businesses. He also thanked Councilman Lehman for a wonderful Senior Tour.

Bob Martin-103 Woodland Terr.-Explained that he is having a problem with his neighbor putting his trash on the side of the house. Chief Mark Moore said that he would be happy to have an officer look into it to see if there is any property maintenance violation.

Being there was no further discussion, the meeting was closed to the public by motion of Brandley, seconded by Valianti.

Council gave brief Department updates

Being no further discussion, the meeting was adjourned by motion of Davidson seconded by Lehman.
