Lou Monyious-103 Johnson Ave- asked if there was any update on the USDA Grant for the repair of the sewer system. Mayor Forbes announced that the Borough's application passed the first phase of the review process, which is a good sign.

Paul Yudkowitz-57 Kendall Blvd-asked if there is any other way to get the word out about Borough events. Mayor Forbes said that he would look into maybe getting a newsletter out to residents.
